

# COGNITIVE SCIENCE HONORS PROGRAM

## APPLICATION

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of 9 core courses (101ABC, 102ABC, 107ABC, 109, 118A, 118B)
- Junior standing
- 3.5 GPA in upper-division major courses, and 3.0 overall GPA, to be maintained throughout program

### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of Cog Sci 190A (Fall) with a letter grade of "A-" or better
- Completion of Cog Sci 190B (Winter) with letter grades of "A-" or better, and 198 (Winter; 2 units; P/NP)
- Completion of Cog Sci 190C (Spring) with letter grades of "A-" or better, and 190D (Spring; 1 unit; P/NP)
- Completion of one cognitive science graduate level course (may be taken P/NP)
- Completion of a written honors thesis
- Approval of thesis by honors committee (chosen by student) and department chair
- Satisfactory presentation of the honors thesis in spring quarter

### PRE-HONORS ADMISSION

To apply for the program, you must have completed the eligibility requirements above. Fill out the application below, and present it to your chosen thesis advisor for signature. When you return this form to the Undergraduate Staff Advisor (CSB 140), you will receive the section ID code to enroll in Cog Sci 190A, Pre-Honors Project in Cognitive Science.

### HONORS PROGRAM ADMISSION DEADLINES

- DUE BY FRIDAY OF FINALS WEEK, FALL QUARTER:** Your written Honors Project proposal must be submitted to your thesis advisor at the end of the fall quarter. The proposal will define the question to be investigated, survey existing literature, describe the approach and methods that will be used, explain how data will be collected if it is an empirical study, detail how human subjects requirements will be met if necessary, discuss expected results, and provide a timeline for project completion.
- DUE BY FRIDAY OF 1<sup>ST</sup> WEEK, WINTER QUARTER:** Once your advisor has reviewed your proposal and COGS 190A is completed with a letter grade of "A-" or better, please pick up an "Honors Program Admission Form" from Thanh Maxwell. You will need to indicate and obtain signatures from your honors committee composed of 2 faculties and 1 graduate student. One of the faculties should be designated as primary advisor. Consult with your COGS 190A advisor about who to ask to be on this committee.
- TUES OF 2<sup>ND</sup> WEEK, WINTER QUARTER:** Once your application has been reviewed by the Cognitive Science Honors Program Committee, check with Thanh Maxwell to find out if you have been granted admission to the program. At that point, you will be given the section ID code to enroll in COGS 190B, Honors Studies in Cognitive Science, formally securing your space in the Cognitive Science Honors Program.
